

The problem with dropped objects is a well-known challenge in the offshore industry. It is a major safety issue with a great risk potential. Dropped-object training is developed for staff working at heights or in surroundings that may be affected by dropped objects.

The training is based on the participants' own experience, situations from the industry in general and training material from recognized business partners. The training program may be customized to include specified sceneries/challenges based on customers' requests.

The training will increase the participants' **awareness** of potential dropped objects and it will contribute to an improved **safety culture** and a higher level of focus on safety for the individual participant. Furthermore, it will give the participants **knowledge** of safe work at heights without compromises and according to recognized guidelines and **best practices**.

  - Definition of potential dropped objects.
- Theory
  - What causes dropped objects?
  - How to spot potential dropped objects.
  - Static and dynamic dropped objects.
  - Dropped object prevention.
  - How to work safer without dropped objects.
  - Change of behaviour and mindset.
- Practice
  - Finding potential dropped objects.
  - Securing of potential dropped objects.
- Open discussion
  - How to implement this in real life.
